The MRC Integrated Toxicology Training Partnership (ITTP) is a national programme for training and capacity building across complementary disciplines of toxicology research (including in vitro and in vivo mechanisms of toxicity, clinical and epidemiological studies, drug safety, and environmental and regulatory toxicology), with the aim of improving and boosting capacity in the toxicological sciences. A key objective is to provide to relevant stakeholders in academia, industry and government the expertise in toxicology and related disciplines that is required to ensure the safe and effective development of drugs and exposure to chemicals. This symposium will provide key topics of relevance to both stakeholders and the wider toxicology field, covering the diverse repertoire of this initiative. The session will culminate in a reflection session to drive discussion around this theme.
