

EARLY CAREER INVESTIGATOR AWARD 2019

This award is made in recognition of leading contributions to toxicology by early Career Investigators (within 10 years of PhD).

Eligibility

- No more than 10 years postdoctoral (or 14 years postgraduate)
 experience by 1st January 2019
- ~ Current member of the British Toxicology Society.

Nomination for the award must include the following

- ~ A full CV
- Four recent and scientifically relevant publications where the applicant has a first or senior author position
- A description (up to 1000 words) of the candidates achievements to date
- A letter of recommendation from the Head of Department or another senior toxicologist

DEADLINE 31ST JANUARY 2019

The winner must be available to present their work at the 2019 BTS Annual Congress - April 15-17 2019. Following the presentation the winner will receive a £250 cheque and a commemorative certificate. The winner will be invited to submit a paper for publication in the Society's journal Toxicology Research. Registration for the Congress will be waived and travel and accommodation allowances provided.

Applications should be submitted to the BTS Secretariat by 31st January 2019. There will be a single award annually. Applications will be considered by the Scientific Sub-Committee (SSC) in February and the winner will be notified by the Chair of the SSC following ratification by the BTS Executive Committee.
